

## **Org Administration**

Positioning you to self-manage your PMX

1. If you are a PLAYER MAP X-Ray (PMX) Org Administrator, you have the Org Admin link in your PMX.

2. The Organization Admin Console enables you to manage users, add users to PMX\*, and pull reports (please note that the Usage Report can be generated on a monthly basis by Player Map upon request).

Organization Admin Console	
Add User Registration	When you add or suspend a PMX user, PMX e-mails Player Map with an update to ensure that we remain in sync with your PMX user count.
Reports <u>Current User List</u> <u>Usage Report (2015-04-06)</u>	Suspending an active PMX user or deleting a PMX registration <i>credits</i> your license count – deleting an already suspended user is zero credit.

3. Users appear in this table, and note that you can scroll or search for them by e-mail, first or last name.

Status identifies: Active on PMX, their PMX is Locked, they are Registered but not set up, or if their PMX is Suspended – actions are: View PMs, Transfer PMs after Suspended, Reinstate or Delete. \*\*\* Note you should transfer Player Maps before deleting person – deleting is permanent \*\*\*

4. After you suspend a person, then you can transfer all their Player Maps to another PMX account (PMX creates a folder titled "transferred from e-mail" in the account of the new Player Maps owner).

\* You can add people to PMX up to your current number of licenses – if you exceed licenses, PMX will prompt you to suspend/delete users or contact Player Map to secure more licenses.

5. If you are *not* suspending a PMX user, but would like to move their Player Map(s) to a new owner, select **View PMs...**, click the <u>Change Owner</u> link, select the new owner from the dropdown list and click **Change Owner**, then PMX will transfer the Player Map to the **Solo** folder of the new owner.
